DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES	 Manage the day-to-day operations of the bar, including opening and closing procedures, inventory management, and staff scheduling. Hire, train, and manage bar staff, including bartenders, servers, and support staff. Ensure that all staff are properly trained on menu items, customer service standards, and safety procedures. Develop and implement policies and procedures to ensure that the bar operates smoothly and efficiently. Monitor inventory levels and order supplies as needed to maintain adequate stock levels. Manage the budget for the bar, including forecasting sales, controlling costs, and managing labor expenses.
